

prey, reptiles, and birds of the air. ⁷**I also heard a voice saying to me, “Get up, Peter; kill and eat.”** ⁸**But I replied, “By no means, Lord; for nothing profane or unclean has ever entered my mouth.”** ⁹But a second time the voice answered from heaven, **“What God has made clean, you must not call profane.”** ¹⁰This happened three times; then everything was pulled up again to heaven. ¹¹At that very moment three men, sent to me from Caesarea, arrived at the house where we were. ¹²The Spirit told me to go with them and not to make a distinction between them and us. **These six brothers also accompanied me, and we entered the man’s house.** ¹³He told us **how he had seen the angel standing in his house and saying, “Send to Joppa and bring Simon, who is called Peter; ¹⁴he will give you a message by which you and your entire household will be saved.”** ¹⁵And as I began to speak, the Holy Spirit fell upon them just as it had upon us at the beginning. ¹⁶And I remembered the word of the **Lord, how he had said, “John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”** ¹⁷If then God gave them the same gift that he gave us when we **believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, who was I that I could hinder God?’** ¹⁸When they heard this, they were silenced. **And they praised God, saying, ‘Then God has given even to the Gentiles the repentance that leads to life.’**

³¹**During the supper, when Judas had gone out, Jesus said, ‘Now the Son of Man has been glorified, and God has been glorified in him. ³²If God has been glorified in him, God will also glorify him in himself and will glorify him at once. ³³Little children, I am with you only a little longer. You will look for me; and as I said to the Jews so now I say to you, “Where I am going, you cannot come.”** ³⁴I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. ³⁵By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have **love for one another.’**
