*Luke 2.15-21*

*When the Gospel is announced the reader says*

Hear the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ according to Luke.

All Glory to you, O Lord.

<sup>15</sup>When the angels had left them and gone into heaven, the shepherds said to  
**one another, 'Let us go now to Bethlehem and see this thing that has taken  
place, which the Lord has made known to us.'** <sup>16</sup>So they went with haste and  
found Mary and Joseph, and the child lying in the manger. <sup>17</sup>When they saw  
this, they made known what had been told them about this child; <sup>18</sup>and all  
who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds told them. <sup>19</sup>But Mary  
treasured all these words and pondered them in her heart. <sup>20</sup>The shepherds  
returned, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen, as it  
had been told them.

<sup>21</sup>After eight days had passed, it was time to circumcise the child; and he was  
called Jesus, the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the  
womb.
